Get your groove on...it is competition time!!! Lincoln, NB or bust!! Bundle up, it is suppose to be just as cold in Nebraska as it is here but there is no precipitation in the forecast.

If you are planning to ride the bus to Lincoln, NB the cost has been reduced to **\$25** per seat. We will also be having a group meal at Spaghetti Works in Lincoln, NB. The cost for the meal is **\$12** for adults and children 5 yrs and under is **\$5**. The meal includes salad bar, pick your own pasta and sauce, garlic toast and non-alcoholic beverage; tax and gratuity are included. I have attached a sign-up for both the bus ride and the meal. If you wish to attend either of these venues, please contact Cindy See at 201-3336. You must pay for these in advance.

Elite Energy's block of rooms are booked. If you still wish to attend you may call the Embassy Suites at 1-800-362-2779 to reserve a room but the cost will be whatever they have available.

Also, a reminder, we must have a copy of a state ID or driver's license for your student by the time we leave for Lincoln, NB. A couple of years ago we ran into a dilemma with this and we have started requiring this for travel. The copy of the information simply gets filed with their medical consent so that we have it in case of an emergency. We will not use the information for any other reason.

A state ID card can be obtained at the DMV. The cost is \$10. You must have proof of identification, this can be a certified copy of their birth certificate, a social security card and proof of current residency (mail your child a blank envelope).

The bus for Lincoln, NB will leave EHS at 6:30 a.m. Students should arrive by 6:00 a.m. for luggage checks. We will be checking for white EEE polo shirts, khaki pants, black socks and any contraband (ie, drugs, cigarettes and alcohol). These are strictly prohibited and your student will be sent home immediately if found in your student's possession.
