Good evening! This is another busy week for EEE. Rehearsals will be Tuesday, Feb 2, 5:30-9pm and Thursday, Feb 4, 6-9pm. The students will load the trailer on Thursday night after practice. Thursday, Feb 4 is also a **general booster club** meeting at **7 pm** in the library.

Our next competition is this Saturday, February 6 at Danville, IL.

- Bus with the students leaves promptly at 8 am. We should arrive in Danville around 9:30/9:45 am.
- Our homeroom is Room 250.
- The trailer will not be unloaded as we will unload on Friday night during the junior high competition.
- We have 2 soloists – Priscilla Washburn performs at 11 am and Amanda Bohn performs at 11:10 am in the Danville High School Little Theater.
- We also have a dance team that will perform at 12 noon in the Danville High School Little Theater.
- EEE performs at 2:30 pm in the auditorium. Finals begin at 7pm in the auditorium.
- We will be using dry ice for this competition. However, no food or drink is allowed in the classrooms. This is grounds for disqualification.
- Admission cost is as follows: Saturday prelim only – Students \$8, Srs (65+) \$8 and Adults \$10. Finals only – Students \$8, Srs (65+) \$8 and Adults \$10. An all day pass for Saturday (prelims and finals) – Students \$12, Srs \$12 and adults \$16. We will be giving the students money for lunch and dinner.
- The students will be returning to EHS very late on Saturday night/Sunday morning, like 1:30/2:00 am. This competition is notorious for running very late.

I know some parents/students are going on Friday for the Jr. High competition and staying all night because the Jr High also gets done very late. If you are one of these parents could you just drop me an email and confirm this so I know who is not riding the bus to and from Danville. Don't assume I know who you are.
