### **Goals**

As of July 1, you should have at least \$600 in your child's account or have been working bingo. **You must have at least \$900 in your child's account in order for them to attend retreat on August 20-22.** Obviously we have not set a goal amount yet but you are expected to work Majestic Bingo or make cash payments each month, \$300.

**Your child's \$75 participation fee is PAST DUE. If you still have not paid your participation fee, it can be mailed to Kirk Myers. This is the only cash payment absolutely required of you during the fiscal year. All other monies can be fundraised.**

If you have any questions regarding your account, you can contact Judy Sawyer. Fundraisers are very important to raising the money for your child's goal for the year.

Those parents paying cash should have paid \$600 by July 1. If you are not paying cash on a monthly basis you should be signed up for a bingo shift. If you are not signed up for bingo, contact Gary Sawyer.
