Goals

As of June 1, you should have at least \$300 in your child's account or have been working bingo. Obviously we have not set a goal amount yet but you are expected to work Majestic Bingo or make cash payments each month, \$300. If you were over goal last year you can carry over 20% for the next fiscal year.

Your child's \$75 participation fee is due NOW. They can be mailed to Kirk Myers. This is the only cash payment absolutely required of you during the fiscal year. All other monies can be fundraised.

If you have any questions regarding your account, you can contact Judy Sawyer. Fundraisers are very important to raising the money for your child's goal for the year. Student accounts will be emailed by June 10.

Those parents paying cash should have paid \$300 by June 1. If you are not paying cash on a monthly basis you should be signed up for a bingo shift. If you are not signed up for bingo contact Gary Sawyer.
