Good evening everyone! Hope all is well.

It is officially a new year. If you are receiving this hotline your child has made the list for the 2010-11 Eisenhower Elite Energy Show Choir. ### Goals

Goals are all new as of May 1. Obviously we have not set a goal amount yet but you are expected to work Majestic Bingo or make cash payments each month, \$300. If you were over goal last year you can carry over 20% for the next fiscal year.

**Your child's \$75 participation fee is due by June 1, 2010. Kirk has only received 11 out of the total 52. They can be mailed to him. This is the only cash payment absolutely required of you during the fiscal year. All other monies can be fundraised.**

If you have any questions regarding your account, you can contact Judy Sawyer. Fundraisers are very important to raising the money for your child's goal for the year. Judy will have goal sheets out at the beginning of each month.

### Majestic Bingo

This is **Week 4** so it is time for **Team 4** to work. **We need 5 full shifts and 2 half shifts to fill this week.** Please arrive at the Majestic Hall no later than **4:15 pm**. If you need a sub or cannot work due to illness or injury, please contact Gary Sawyer or Jeff Burnham.

**If you have not signed up for a bingo shift then you must do so, you can contact either Gary or Jeff to do this. Week 1 is full but we still need many workers for Weeks 2, 3 and 4. This is how you fundraise your child's goal, you must sign up for a bingo week! If you plan to pay cash you must contact Judy Sawyer and let her know.**

From here on out, if you are working and do not need the money in your child's account please just sign "Donate" where your child's name would be. This will allow for privacy as to a child's account status. The assistant treasurer and bingo treasurer will divide this money up evenly so that every child who needs help will be given equal opportunity at it and no one will be left behind.

Even though our competition season is over, our time commitment is not. Majestic Bingo is a 12 month commitment, May-May. Also, **please be mindful during our transition time with the new group in May.** If you are available to work, please try to help out. Be good mentors in helping our new parents get accustomed to working bingo.
