Here's a great way to add to your student's account -- sell ads in our annual Holiday Preview Book. This book will be used as the program for the Holiday Preview show and also Senior Spotlight. Better yet, 100% of the revenue from ad sales goes directly into your student account. Attached to the Hotline is all of the information you will need. Note that there is a protected ad list. These are ads that were sold by students last year and those students get first shot at re-selling those ads. The list will be protected for two weeks, until Oct. 12. There is also a list of ads from last year's program that are not protected -- these ads were sold by students who are no longer with EEE. For each ad sold, you must include the ad (either camera ready or on CD, an ad contract and payment. Please don't staple the ad copy. Judy or I will be at the beginning of Thursday rehearsals to receive ads. We will put out a "sold" list each week in the Hotline. Parents or families can also purchase ads to congratulate and encourage their student. The deadline for ad sales is Nov. 1. Attached to this Hotline is the protected ad list, advertisers from last year who are "unprotected", guidelines for selling ads and the ad contract. Let's make this preview book the best ever and remember, 100% of ad sales go directly into your student's account.
